Requirements for the **Art History Major**:

Nine courses, minimum.

Up to be three may be taken in another program if you study away junior year.

The Nine courses must consist of:

- Any three ARTH 100-level courses offered
- Any ARTS (studio) course
- One course in art history concerned with a period prior to 1800
- One course in art history concerned with a period post 1800
- ARTH 301 / 302: Methods of Art History.
Note: ARTH 301 / 302 can only be taken at Williams, Oxford or UC London
- One 400-level seminar or 500-level graduate seminar.
Note: The seminar must be taken at Williams. It may fulfill pre- or post-1800 requirement.
- One additional ARTH course, at any level.
